**AQUARIAN AERATORS AND ICE-AWAY DE-ICERS
#90PG5X10 PROPELLER GUARD INSTALLATION PROCEDURE**

!WARNING: The “propeller guard” is NOT to be considered a safety device and has not been tested for the prevention of personal injury.

- STEP 1** Remove propeller guard and ty-raps from shipping carton.
- STEP 2** Place the unit on a flat surface, with the diffuser against the surface (see picture “A” below). Place the propeller guard over the motor and slide it down over the diffuser arms, aligning the bottom edge of the propeller guard with the bottom of the diffuser (motor/propeller shaft end).
- STEP 3** The top edge of the propeller guard should be approximately 3” from the edge of the diffuser when measured along the diffuser arm (See picture B). Attach one plastic ty-rap around the diffuser arm and through the third row from the top, of the ½” square openings of the propeller guard. This should be done on both sides of the propeller guard. Cinch the ties and cut off the excess plastic.
- STEP 4** Attach the remaining two ty-raps in the same manner as the first two only locate the ty-raps on the opposite edge of the guard again around the diffuser arm at the third row.
